ADVANCEMENT

Quarter three has been one of transition. Many students are back on their designated campus; however, they contend with hybrid employer recruitment through institutional virtual career fairs and employer-hosted virtual engagement. We find that CAMP students are more likely to miss out on virtual participation as it requires multiple steps to access a virtual space. In this light, we are countering the matter by co-hosting informational programming, targeting CAMP students. For example, this quarter NMSI with Kellogg's Co. hosted a national virtual info session for students, with the intent to recruit and build a placement pipeline for CAMP participants. We intentionally eliminate barriers that so often CAMP students encounter. NMSI has persistently engaged with the University leadership and advancement team to secure long-term funding. In addition, strategically establishing *Memorandum of Understandings* with individual universities to support and ensure access to students and essential data points, in order to better advise and prepare the future workforce and employers. Additionally, we are strategically targeting specific majors across the country that will enhance the agriculture industry through STEM. We look forward to ending the year strong as we transition into a new phase: post-pandemic.
